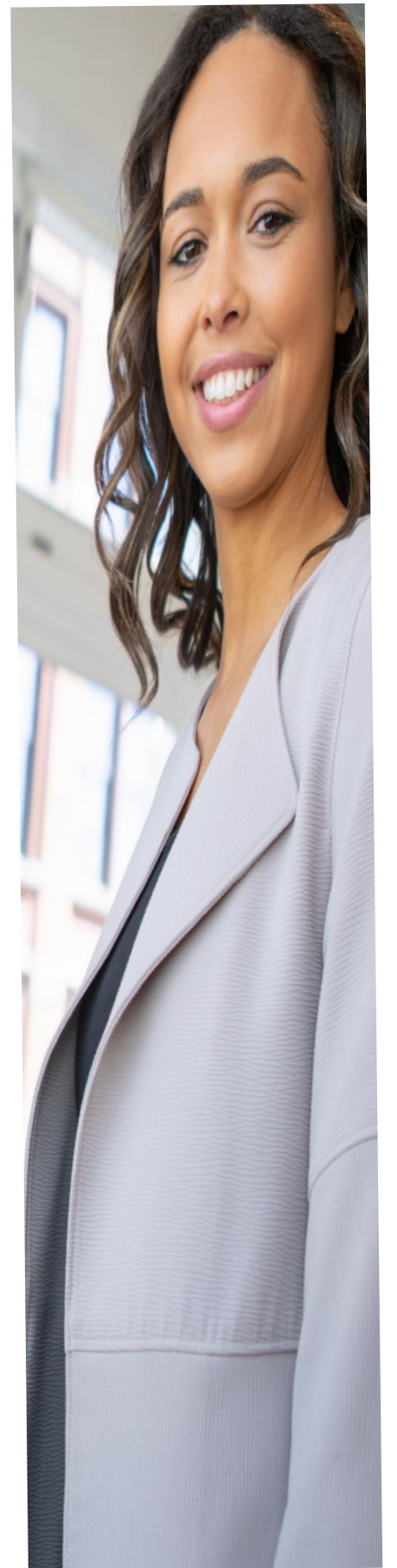
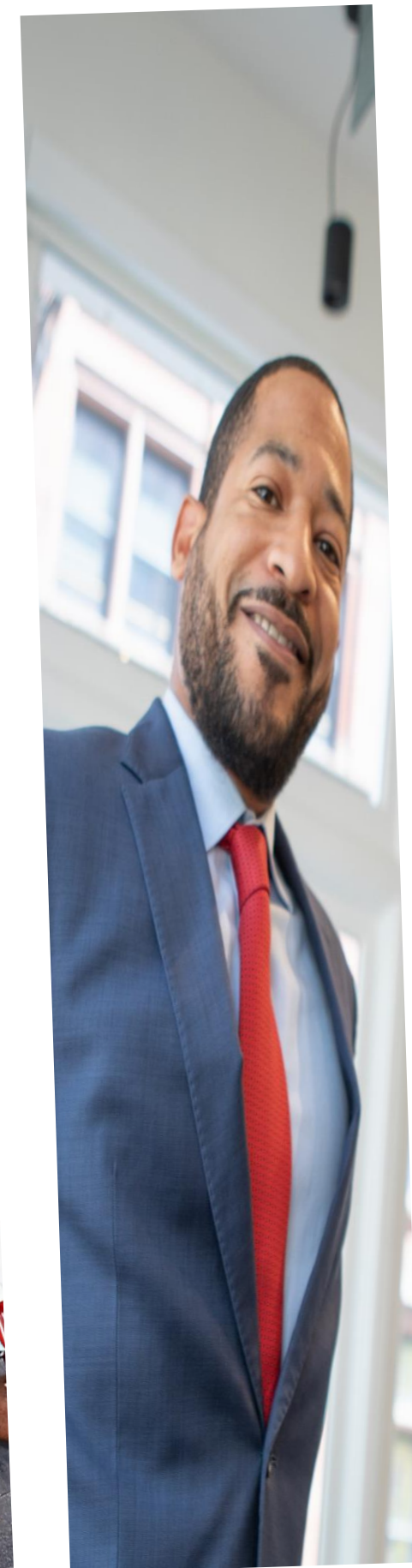
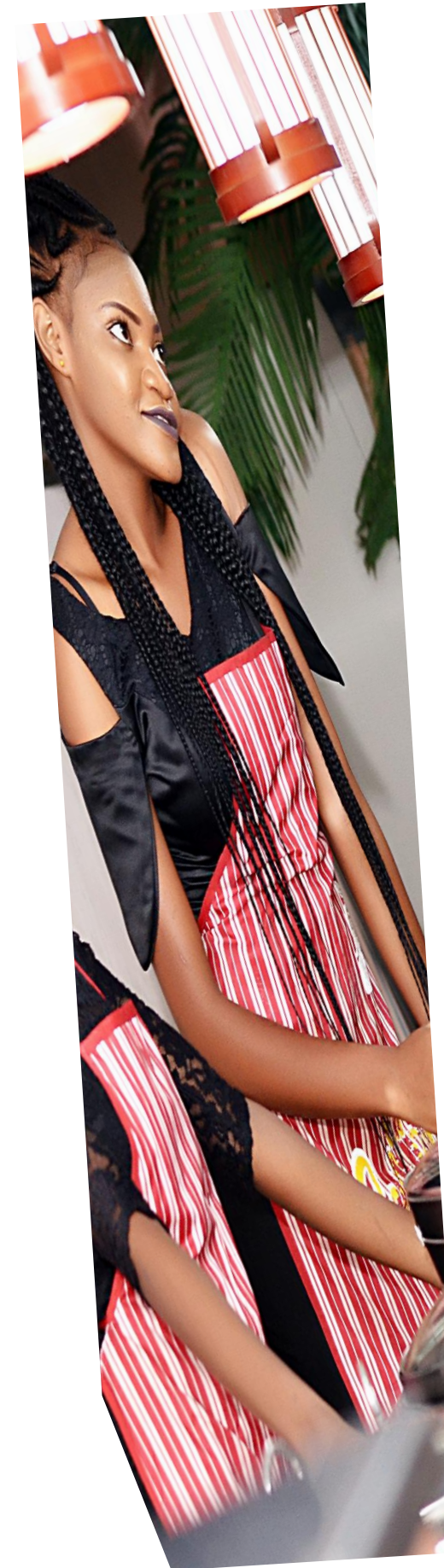
# SME DEVELOPMENT
